### BANGKOK – THAILAND'S PULSING CAPITAL

Then decompress with thousands of other backpackers in Southeast Asia's largest tourist hub – the legendary Khao San Road!

### CHIANG MAI – CULTURAL CHARM IN THE NORTH

Ancient temples, night bazaars, elephant sanctuaries, and charmingly-chic nightlife define Chiang Mai and make this small city a favorite destination for tourists from around the world. Here we will meet with leaders of local non-profit organizations working on prevention – keeping at-risk children safe in school and far away

from human trafficking. And, of course, soak in the culture and help bathe some local elephants.

### CHIANG RAI – RURAL ADVENTURE AND RICE PADDIES

Nestled way up in the Golden Triangle region of Thailand, Chiang Rai and the surrounding villages is where we'll experience the charming, bucolic life that represents "The Real Thailand." From swimming in waterfalls to boat rides through the rice paddies, this is our chance to get OUT there and have an adventure. Here, we will be working with local schools and after school centers to provide education and sustainable development to children in need of our support, and engage in cultural exchange with local communities.



### UNDERSTAND THE ISSUES

Understand the massive human trafficking and child exploitation epidemic in Southeast Asia and how it affects people around the world. This isn't your typical classroom – you'll be learning about these issues on-site with the world-changers who are fighting the battles on the ground and gaining deep insight into the root of one of the world's largest human rights issues.

### HANDS-ON SERVICE WORK

Bring your unique skills and vision to help educate and inspire Thai youth. Teach English in local schools, lead activities for at-risk children, and run sessions for victimized teens. Make a lasting impact on these children and help either prevent them from getting caught up in the sordid path of human trafficking, or help those already involved find normalcy and a new direction.

### INCREDIBLE CULTURAL EXPERIENCES

Enjoy elephant rides at an environmentally responsible elephant camp, long-boat rides through the rice paddies of Northern Thailand, and teach English at local schools for Thai Children. Most evenings are free to explore on your own or with the group. Support the local economy by purchasing hand-made goods in local street markets. Try exotic Thai delicacies and fruits, enjoy jungle hikes, zip lining & swimming at the bottom of spectacular waterfalls.

### JEWISH SOCIAL JUSTICE AND LEADERSHIP PROGRAMMING

Understand what our tradition reveals about the cause of suffering in the world while participating in Tikkun Olam. Empower yourself to dig deep to find meaning and leadership abilities with which to go out and make a difference in your own life and the world around you.
